Although our caves may be a bit on the small size, we're sure you'll find there is plenty of wonderful things to do and places to see here in the Skylands region of the Garden State – whether it be above or below ground or on-site at the NRO or in surrounding area.

The NRO venue is a member's property located at 25 Hunt's School Road, Newton, NJ 07860. Note the property is in Green Township, but for purposes of using a GPS, Google Maps, Mapquest, etc. Newton, NJ should be entered as the town. Please see the attached directions and map for more detail regarding finding your way to the Spring NRO site.

There will be plenty of space for rustic camping available, and wonderful on-site activities are planned. NNJG will be cooking up delicious meals for Saturday's breakfast and dinner, and breakfast on Sunday. Saturday night's entertainment will include the NCC Auction followed by live music provided by Bad Beer (a classic rock band), along with a bonfire, hot-tub, and movies/slideshows. Remember to bring your vertical gear for use on the zip-line, vertical practice/training ropes, and speleo-obstacle course that will also be present on site.

Northwestern New Jersey does have many destinations for all your favorite outdoor activities - from hiking to biking (mountain or road) and from canoeing/kayaking to rock-climbing as well as geocaching and sight-seeing. So do remember to bring your bike, canoe or kayak, climbing-gear, GPS, and so on if you would like to engage in such activities during the NRO weekend. # Spring 2011 NRO Location and Directions


Spring 2011 NRO location:



#### Directions to NRO via I-80 & Route 206:

- From I-80 take Rt 206 North (exit 25)
- Go about 8 miles and turn left at traffic light onto Route 611
- Go about 3 miles to the first right turn onto Route 608 / Shotwell Rd
- Go about 3/4 mile to the second left on to Hunt's School Road
- Go about 3/4 mile in on right just before the old schoolhouse. There is a red 25 on a tree by the driveway.





### **WNS Policy for Spring 2011 NRO:**

In keeping with NSS policy on White Nose Syndrome, all cave closure orders will be respected. Only non-bat caves will be available for caving. As always, we strongly urge that any cave gear used here in the WNS-saturated Northeast not be taken out of the region. We ask that all cavers clean and disinfect their clothing and gear according to the USFWS protocols, which were recently updated in February.
