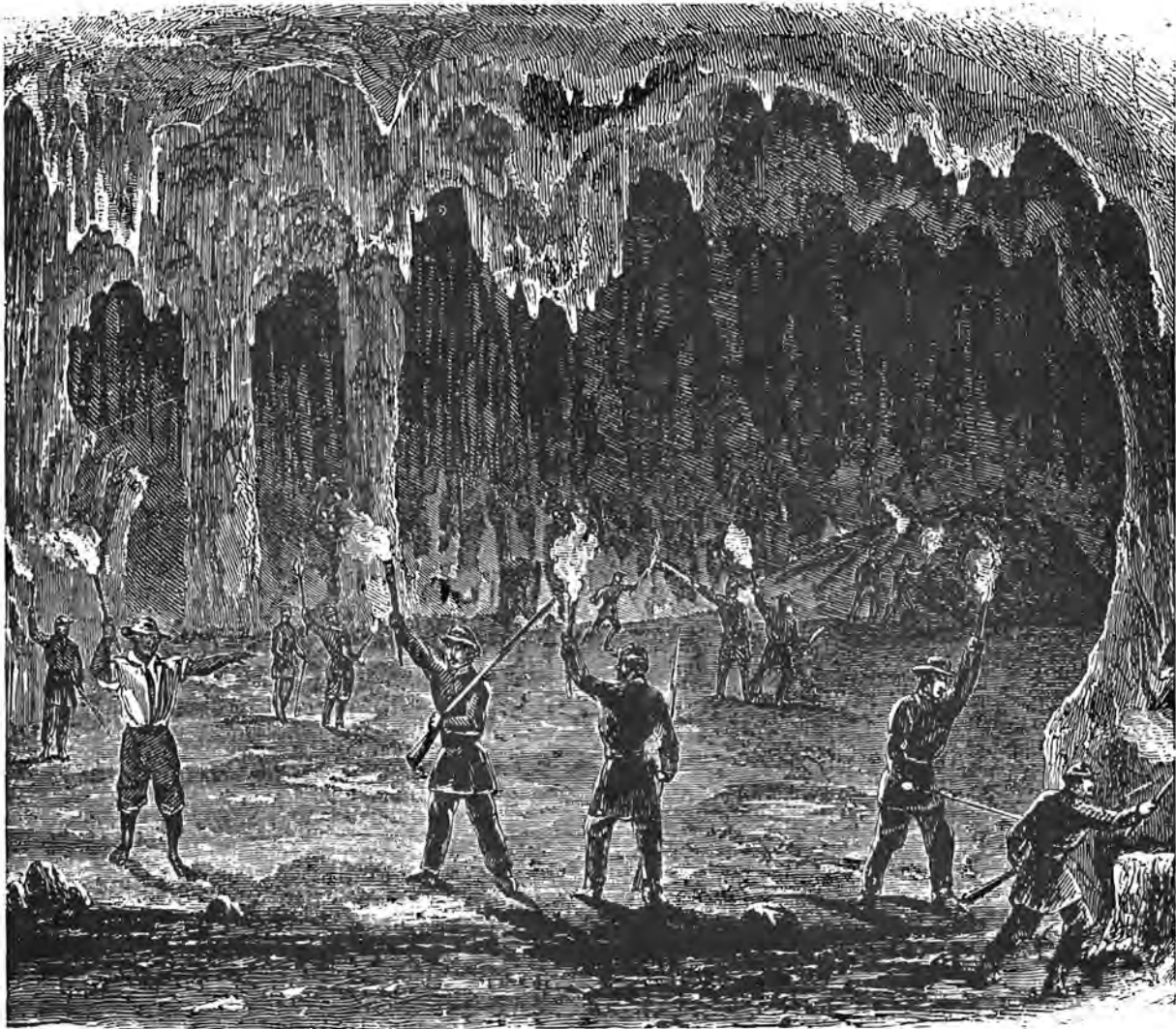

*The Niter Gardener's Guide and Home Companion:
The Saltpeter Cave Survey, 1994*

Introduction

To this author's knowledge, the first attempt to list all known saltpeter cave names across the entire United States appeared in the October, 1981 issue of the *NSS Bulletin*, with a followup revision of the listing in the October, 1982 issue. The "Saltpeter Symposium," as it was known, not only contained a 13-state, 377-cave listing of all the saltpeter caves then known, but a number of scholarly historic and scientific articles dealing with various aspects of the saltpeter mining processes.

The cave name section gave only the state and county; all other information was withheld (if other information was actually known at all) with the reader urged to contact local grottos if visits to the caves or other pertinent information was desired. Presumably, vandalism was the key issue regarding this decision.

In November of 1990, following publication of several listings of currently known Tennessee saltpeter caves in the Cumberland Valley Grotto *Subterranean Times*, I began thinking about revising the Symposium cave list: certainly within ten years, and with the proliferation of new caves (over 3000 in Tennessee alone during that time period), more saltpeter caves should have been found. This proved to not only be correct, but a major task to compile.

Thus began a three year project, which basically ended in January of 1994 as the final cutoff date for accepting the general flood of cave names which began pouring in after contacting the likes of Marion O. Smith, Jerry Vineyard, Dave Hubbard, and others. And what began as a limited listing of only the TAG region soon mushroomed into a 669-cave and 15-state catalogue.

From the beginning, I knew that I wanted more information in my list than was present in the Symposium. I decided against publishing exact locations, feeling it was not necessary nor prudent, but I did decide to put in enough information that the reader could distinguish between so many of the generically-named "Saltpeter Caves."

One of the main reasons why I decided to expand greatly on the Symposium presentation format was the knowledge that not all saltpeter caves known were definitely mined, and quite a few of the caves marked "Saltpeter Cave" had marginal information available, and in fact may not have been mined for niter at all despite the name. Thus I felt it necessary to include in my presentation format a site determination assessment, a measure of the extent of the appearance of mining activity conducted (or not) in the cave.

Another practical aspect of expanding the Symposium format was simply to distinguish between "Saltpeter Cave" in County X and "Saltpeter Cave" also in County X. It was possible that they could have been one and the same cave; it was necessary to go into greater detail in order to have an accurate cave count. Thus, in one of the two formats I did adopt, I added topo names, cave lengths and the source of information. Knowing that this would upset some in the caving community, another, less detailed alphabetical format was called for.

As I was combing through some of the state information, other problems made themselves known. The lack of a unified state cave survey in one state in particular gave rise to a cave being called two or three different names by several caving groups within the state.

In addition, it also became obvious that not everyone agrees on just what constitutes a cave and what is a rockshelter. I had to define in my listing those two terms as well as make a value judgement on what to call each cave in the listing. In the end, only one definition for cave and rockshelter was used, and only one cave name was allowed. Refer to the "Accuracy of Information" heading for further remarks.

I am not particularly a historian and I make no claims to have extensively researched volumes of information concerning each cave given herein; this is merely a list of cave names and limited information for each. It is not meant to "sabotage" anyone's hard work, largely, it is only as accurate as the material I was sent. All contributors are named and essentially credit is due them rather than me.

It is assumed and hoped that none of the information contained in the Guide will be used to negatively impact the caves or the caving community as a whole. I see this as the beginning of a constantly updated and comprehensive data base for use by all those within the caving community interested in saltpeter caves.

It is believed that possibly a great many of the caves listed are not in grave danger of vandalism, as many of the more sensitive sites are gated or otherwise protected. As another important site becomes known it in turn is given similar protection. However, most of the caves are either in extremely poor states of preservation, contain no artifacts, have marginally mined areas, or may actually not have been mined at all. Some are local "sacrifice" caves, or are "pothunter's paradises." It is not assumed by this author that dissemination of this list in a caver-oriented (and limited) journal will encourage vandalism. In fact, conservationists in these cave-rich states will now have a potential data base for preservation activities regarding these historic sites. They are encouraged to use it as such.

Terminology

For the purposes of this Project, a cave will be defined as meeting the following criteria;

1. At least 30 feet in horizontal length
2. A natural, humanly penetrable opening in the country rock, extending underground as passage large enough to have carried on mining activities
3. No limit on geologic strata or combinations thereof
4. A cave may begin beneath a rockshelter, but a rockshelter will not have penetrable cave passage

Similarly, a rockshelter may contain features akin to a cave, but for a contextual definition of the term, a rockshelter will be defined as meeting the following criteria:

1. Is merely a simple rock shelf or overhang in a bluff
2. No cave passage present as defined previously
3. Is usually completely within daylight, as opposed to a cave which contains a "twilight" zone as well as total darkness.
4. No limit on geologic strata or combinations thereof, although usually a rockshelter is contained within a single strata

I realize that the defining line between the terms is a narrow one; saltpeter-mined rockshelters, however, are quite common and should require a study of their own. It is hoped that no actual "rockshelters" made it onto this listing. As for other corrections and criticism, refer to the address I have provided for correspondence.

For obvious reasons, a cave is considered to be a saltpeter cave only if it was actually mined for niter, or strongly felt to have been. Caves in the "Q" category of Site Determination Assessment are only included because the author could not find enough substantial evidence to prove that the cave was *not* mined- all these caves should be checked out by knowledgeable cavers in their respective states.

Site Determination Assessment

As stated before, this is merely an approximate measure, or rule of thumb, used to determine the extent or appearance of mining activity conducted at the cave. This is based primarily on immediate evidence seen in the cave in the form of digging, artifacts seen, historical accounts, and written records. Some caves were used for more than one sort of mine; i.e., epsom salts, copperas, alum, and many of the sites were vandalized by pothunters and archaeologists searching for Indian artifacts. However, the Site Determination Assessment takes all these factors into account wherever possible. The SDA is as follows:

D - Definitely Mined

A cave which has been undeniably judged by knowledgeable cavers to have been mined for niter, as evidenced by unmistakable signs of *saltpeter* mining activity. These signs are usually backed up by some historical or written records, but not necessarily so. Basically, it is very easy to see that the specific type of saltpeter digging was done (as opposed to the limited type of archaeological localities).

S - Suspected To Have Been Mined

A slight downgrade of the "D" category, it is not nearly as easy to make a quick determination that this cave was in fact mined for niter; factors such as in-cave erosion, vandalism, other types of digging, even commercialization of the cave may come into account here. Historical records may or may not exist. It is felt by knowledgeable cavers that the cave "might have" been mined but possibly could not have been. An intermediate category between "definitely" and "questionable." The clues are not as evident although some are seen, enough of them in fact to say that niter mining "might have" been carried on.

Q - Questionable Site

A cave in this category shows few, if any, signs of mining activity. This cave may be reported by locals to be "the old saltpeter cave" but it is very difficult to ascertain this as fact. Some caves in this category may have been vandalized to the extent that signs of niter mining are obliterated. Very few, if any, historical records may exist for this cave. Perhaps a few old names and dates are the only clues left, along with some evidence of niter digging. It will take a trained eye to make a determination as to whether this cave has ever been mined. Perhaps many of the "Saltpeter Caves" in this listing are in this category. It is hoped that "trained eyes" will make determinations of all these "Q" caves and either move them up to "D" or "S", or eliminate them entirely from the data base.

Accuracy of Information

Undoubtedly there will be mistakes in this presentation, which have been corrected in as much as the author has been made aware of them.

The most likely sources of "misinformation" are:

1. The total known number of saltpeter caves within a certain location
2. The cave name
3. Length of the cave and map availability
4. Site determination assessment

It is felt by the author that, where given, the cave survey numbers, topographic names, and the source of information are accurate.

Although it is likely that several of the states have more saltpeter caves than reported here, it is believed that Kentucky in particular has more than the 116 caves in this listing. I also suspect that some of the Kentucky cave names may be incorrect, due to the fact that there is, at this writing, no established state cave survey to iron out such problems. If anyone cares to offer corrections or additions to the Kentucky list, or to any other, they are welcome to contact me at the address provided.

All information regarding Texas and Maryland caves is reproduced verbatim from the Symposium listing- there were no replies to the author's many requests for information regarding those states.

Although information from Missouri and Arkansas was readily forthcoming and available, provided by Jerry Vineyard and Dave Taylor, respectively, both were quick to add that little is actually known concerning the saltpeter history of their states; it is felt that Missouri in particular has more saltpeter sites than named here, and that few of the ones that are named have been thoroughly checked out. Some very early history is known from both states- and Missouri in particular may have some of the earliest recorded saltpeter mining in the entire USA- but much actual in-cave research has yet to be done to categorize the obviously rich history within these caves.

The actual cave names given here are another possible source of erroneous information. Differing cave groups who occasionally cross paths and "territories" may wind up with two different names and maps. It is possible that some duplications are in this listing.

Consider also that there are over 60 examples of derivatives of the generic name "Saltpeter Cave." It is easy to get these caves mixed up when trying to determine "which cave is which." This problem is especially chaotic when there are several similarly named caves within a region, or in adjoining counties on the same topo. One solution to this mess is to attach a qualifying surname to the generic, such as "Forestville Saltpeter Cave" or "Gilliam Saltpeter Cave." And, as stated before, it always helps to have a centralized state cave survey to sort this out.

Cave lengths are sometimes estimated and not mapped, resulting in some confusion. In this report, some cave maps were consulted which did not have the mapped horizontal length printed on them, and so a few estimates were made in these cases.

As stated before, the Site Determination Assessment is also a potential erroneous factor. I did not visit all the caves listed here and so the SDA is usually estimated based on the amount of information I was provided with.

Comments on the Saltpeter Symposium

The Symposium cave listing showed 280 caves from 12 states in the October, 1981 issue of the *NSS Bulletin*; a year later, the updated list added 97 caves and one more state, Texas.

The "guano-peter" saltpeter caves of Texas were omitted from the 1981 version, the editor of the Symposium, Carol Hill, feeling that such caves were different than "true" saltpeter caves. The difference in the two was that the niter in the bat caves of Texas came primarily from the organic guano source while niter from other caves came from the primarily inorganic clastic sediments whose nitrates derived from leachate from the virgin hardwood forests that overlay the area. However, the Texas caves were included a year later when it became apparent that most saltpeter caves do contain at least some percentage of guano within the layers of sediment. For instance, Hubbard Cave in Tennessee is both a major bat hibernaculum and maternity colony and also the site of a former large saltpeter operation. Would such a cave, obviously filled with both types of sediment- organic and inorganic- be a "true" saltpeter cave by the editor's definition in the 1981 Symposium? Without any disrespect to the Symposium editors, it is felt by this author that any cave which was actually mined for nitrates deserves to be called a true saltpeter cave.

References to possible mining activities in Arizona and Minnesota were made in the introduction to the 1981 saltpeter cave listing. These references were checked out by present day cavers. The existence of saltpeter caves in Arizona remains a mystery, although it seems quite doubtful that they exist, due to the region's dryness. Also, neighboring New Mexico (which was also checked) has no reported saltpeter caves. No replies were received from the several Arizona grottos which the author contacted to obtain information.

As for Minnesota, information was forthcoming which revealed that the probability of niter mining in that particular region is also not very good. It was reported that the explorer Le Seur (1700) had located both niter and copper from the area. Later research proved that the copper referred to by the explorer was in fact "clay with reduced iron content." The references to saltpeter caves "in the Lake Pepin area" were felt by David Gerboth of the Minnesota Speleological Survey to be false; only a few sandstone caves are reported from the area, none of which were reported to have any mining activity associated with them. While it is very likely that mining could have taken place in sandstone caves and rock shelters, as was proven in Kentucky and Tennessee, nothing of the sort seems to have taken place in the Minnesota area.

I had but one problem with the advice of the Symposium editors- when I sought to obtain further information from local grottos. In the confusion created by the vagueness of that list, I kept running into questions that my correspondents needed answers to, such as:

1. Which "Saltpeter Cave" are you referring to.. there are *six* in that county?
2. Are you *sure* that cave is in the right county?
3. We've *never* heard it called by that name before.
4. *Nobody* I ever caved with heard of a cave up there.
5. There are a *lot* of caves up that river that might have been mined... which mine are you talking about?
6. I wish *somebody* would straighten out this whole mess!

It is hoped that this Project adds to the original intent of the Symposium editors without bringing any potential harm to the caves themselves. There are arguments pro and con; however, it is felt by this author, as well as others, that secrecy and mild attempts at censorship would bring more harm (in this case) by encouraging more misinformation and confusion. Without giving away exact locations to the caves, the main objective of this Project is to firmly identify each cave mined for niter so that efforts at restoration, preservation and conservation, regarding them can be carried out,

while at the same time aiding the efforts of researchers interested in preserving unique heritage that the saltpeter caves of the United States have left behind.

The Presentation Formats

Format #1: Alphabetical

Alphabetical cave number (for reference only)

Cave Name: only one name or spelling is used here; there may be others

County Code: see abbreviation table prior to format #1 listing; this was devised in order to prevent confusion by common county names in different states; for example, Jefferson, Monroe, Jackson.

State Code: standard US Post Office abbreviations

Cave Length: given in feet, not meters. When it appears, NA refers to the fact that the cave length was not furnished to the author by the contributor, or deleted according to the contributor's request, or could not be ascertained by visual observations of a cave map, or is otherwise not available.

Site Determination Assessment: D,S, or Q, according to format #2 (see explanation for SDA)

Format #2: By State, Alphabetical by County

County Code

State cave survey number: normally for Tennessee, Alabama, Georgia and Missouri (whenever available); Krejca and Taylor report the beginnings of a numbered state cave survey for Illinois. Both Illinois entries are numbered. Indiana has a numbered state cave survey but the numbers were not available yet.

Cave Name

SDA

Cave length, in feet

7 1/2° Topographic Map Name: Whenever available, and only for this format.

Grade 4 or 5 Map Availability: If this column is marked NA, it does not mean there is no map, only that one was not available at press time, or one was not available to the author.

Source of Information: Usually a letter code with the explanation following the state listing.
